**Decree NB. 3166 of 14 September 1999**

**Promulgates the UNIDROIT Convention on Stolen or Illegally Exported Cultural Objects,  
concluded in Rome, on June 24 1995**

The President of The Republic, empowered by the Article 84,  
clause VIII, of the Federal Constitution,

Considering that the UNIDROIT Convention on Stolen and Illegally  
Exported Objects was concluded in Rome, on June 24 1995;

Considering that the National Congress approved the Multilateral  
Act quoted above through the Legislative Decree NB.4 on January 21  
1999;

Considering that the referred Act entered into force on June 1<sup>st</sup>  
1998;

Considering that the Brazilian Government placed the Adhesion  
Instrument to the referred Convention on March 23 1999, thus being into  
force in Brazil from September 1<sup>st</sup> 1999 on;

#### **DECREES:**

Article 1. The UNIDROIT Convention on Stolen or Illegally  
Exported Cultural Properties, concluded in Rome on June 24 1995, a copy  
of which is enclosed to this Decree, shall be executed and accomplished  
entirely as is put on its text.

Article 2. This Decree enters into force on the date of its publication.
